For those coming in person, meetings will be held at the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) office building, 300 North Washington Square, Lansing, MI 48913 (corner of Washington and Ionia). When you enter, the receptionist can direct you to the meeting room, you may enter and exit quietly at any time, please sign in. Parking is available at two nearby public ramps, one directly south of the building (enter off Ionia) and another ramp directly west of MEDC.
