

Underserved Counties

It is the Council's long-term goal to make quality arts and cultural programs and services available to all 83 counties in the State of Michigan. In order to accomplish that, MCACA has identified 43 underserved counties (listed below). In addition, an underserved community is defined as one in which people lack access to arts programs, services or resources due to geography, economic conditions, cultural background, sociopolitical circumstances, disability, age or other demonstrable factors. The term "community" can refer to a group of people with common heritage or characteristics, whether or not living in the same place.
