



## UNDERSERVED COUNTIES

It is the Council’s long-term goal to make art and cultural programming and services available to all 83 counties in the State of Michigan. In order to assist in the accomplishment of that, the State of Michigan Arts and Culture Council has identified 43 underserved counties (listed below).

An underserved community is defined as one in which persons may lack access to arts and cultural programming, services or resources due to geography, economic conditions, cultural background, sociopolitical circumstances, disability, age, or other demonstrable factors. The term “community” may refer to a group of persons with common heritage or characteristics, whether or not living in the same place.
