**SUBJECT:** FY 2021 Michigan Stages Survival Grant Program Report

Public Act 257 of 2020, which provides FY 2021 supplemental appropriations, allocated \$3.5 million to the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF) to create and execute the Michigan Stages Survival Grant Program. The program provides one-time grants of up to \$40,000 to eligible live music and entertainment venues in Michigan that have experienced a significant financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. These funds are to be used for working capital to support payroll expenses, rent, mortgage payments, utility expenses, or costs related to reopening a business.

The Michigan Independent Venue and Promoter Association (MIVPA) was responsible for accepting, reviewing, and approving applications by February 28, 2021. The Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC), on behalf of the MSF, was responsible for distributing the grant funds based on the recommendation of the MIVPA.

The Act requires the MSF to submit a monthly report to appropriations committees, fiscal agencies, and the state budget office for grants awarded in the previous month, including the name of the recipient of each grant provided under the program by industry, through September 30, 2021. Pursuant to this requirement, attached is a summary of the program awards. This is a complete list of awards and no further reporting is necessary.

Public Act 257 of 2020, which provides FY 2021 supplemental appropriations, allocated \$3.5 million to the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF) to create and execute the Michigan Stages Survival Grant Program. The program provides one-time grants of up to \$40,000 to eligible live music and entertainment venues in Michigan that have experienced a significant financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. These funds are to be used for working capital to support payroll expenses, rent, mortgage payments, utility expenses, or costs related to reopening a business.

Live music and entertainment venues include businesses/organizations that produce and/or present live, disciplined-based performance experiences, to promote and provide connections through creative expression by sharing creative experiences, expressing their own creativity or connecting users with others and themselves.

The Michigan Independent Venue and Promoter Association (MIVPA) was responsible for accepting, reviewing, and approving applications by February 28, 2021. The Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC), on behalf of the MSF, was responsible for distributing the grant funds based on the recommendation of the MIVPA.

MIVPA could retain up to 2.2 percent of the program funds for administrative costs involved in the direct administration of the grants.

To be eligible for a grant under the program, venues had to meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be located in the state of Michigan.
- Produce and/or present live, disciplined-based performance experiences.
- Demonstrate that at least 33 percent of 2019 gross revenues are from the sale of tickets for live music or entertainment events OR that they receive at least 70 percent of its earned revenue through cover charges or tickets sales, production fees or production reimbursements, nonprofit educational initiatives, or the sale of event beverages, food or merchandise.
- Demonstrate their second quarter revenues from April 1-June 30, 2020 were not greater than 10 percent of second quarter revenue from April 1-June 30, 2019.
- Employ no more than 30 employees on a full time basis.
- Existed prior to February 29, 2020.
- Not owned and operated in more than two states.
- Not owned and operated with offices in more than one country.
- Not listed on the national securities exchange as an issuer.

Businesses and venues eligible for the Michigan Stages Survival Grant were not eligible for funds under Section 402 of Public Act 257 of 2020 (Michigan Small Business Survival Grants).

The MSF Board authorized the program on January 14, 2021. Application and eligibility criteria were posted on the <u>michiganbusiness.org/stages</u> landing page. The applications opened for the program at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 21 and closed on January 28 at noon.

A total of 392 applications was received for this funding with 101 grants across 30 counties being awarded. A list of grant awards by industry is included on the following pages. The award information also is available on the MEDC website at https://www.michiganbusiness.org/stages/.
