Christine Roeder, Vice President, Retention and Growth, MEDC welcomed all and requested introductions around the table due to new members present.

David Greco, Legislative Director, MEDC provided a handout and a high-level update of the MEDC legislative priorities that took place during the lame duck session late last year. He is working to set up meetings with new members of the legislature to provide an overview of MEDC does and what activities happening in their respective districts.
