Google's Computer (CS) First Program, in partnership with the **MICHIGAN FILM & DIGITAL MEDIA OFFICE**, is a free program that empowers students to create with technology through computer science clubs. The online, video-based materials target grades 4th - 8th (ages 9-14). All training and materials provided - no computer experience necessary!

THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM ARE TO:

- Increase confidence when using computers
 - Instill courage to try new things
- Grow perseverance when tackling difficult problems
- Provide a sense of belonging in technology for under-represented students
- Demonstrate the impact that CS has in careers and communities

Teachers and community volunteers can create a club in 5 - 10 minutes. Each club has a theme where student projects are built in Scratch, a block-based coding tool. You can choose from:
