**SUBJECT:** FY 2022 Michigan Infrastructure and Michigan Enhancement Grants - Second Quarter Report

Section 1097 of Public Act 87 of 2021, the FY 2022 Omnibus Budget, requires the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF) to provide quarterly updates on the accounting and status of each Michigan Enhancement and Michigan Infrastructure Grant project to the Senate and House Appropriations Committees, the Senate and House Fiscal Agencies, and the State Budget Office. Pursuant to this requirement, attached is the FY 2022 Second Quarter Report.

The Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) serves as the grant administrator for all Michigan Enhancement and Michigan Infrastructure Grants. The MEDC does not determine which projects are considered. Instead, each project is specifically identified in appropriation bills.

Each grantee is required to submit a quarterly report to the MSF that provides the status of the project and an accounting of all funds expended by the recipient. Work to finalize grant agreements is in process. No progress reports were requested from the grantees for the period ending March 31, 2022, because most grantees had not yet entered into a formal agreement. The attached report summarizes the application status for each earmark. Project status updates, as self-reported by the grantees, will be included in future quarterly reports.
