SUBJECT: FY 2023 Michigan Enhancement, Infrastructure, and Economic Development/Workforce

Grants – Fourth Quarter Reports

Section 1096 of Public Act 166 of 2022, the FY 2023 Omnibus Budget, requires the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF) to provide quarterly updates on the accounting and status of each Michigan Enhancement Grant, Michigan Infrastructure Grant, and Economic Development and Workforce Grant project to the Senate and House Appropriations Committees, the Senate and House Fiscal Agencies, and the State Budget Office. Pursuant to this requirement, attached are the FY 2023 fourth quarter reports.

In addition, Public Act 194 of 2022, Public Act 1 of 2023, and Public Act 5 of 2023, contain additional FY 2023 Supplemental Appropriation items, including one-time grants that require quarterly reporting. A separate report is included for those grants as well.

The Michigan Economic Development Corporation serves as the grant administrator for these grants and does not determine which projects are considered. Instead, each project is specifically identified in appropriation bills.

Each grantee is required to submit a quarterly report to the MSF that provides the status of the project and an accounting of all funds expended by the recipient. The attached reports summarize the status for each earmark, as self-reported by the grantees.

The Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) is serving as grant administrator for the Workforce Grants and will submit a separate report on those projects.
